Creating Clean, Comfortable and Compliant Long-Term Care **Environments Can Be a Challenge**

Facilities must comply with additional infection prevention requirements

▶ As November 28, 2019, CMS requires participating long-term care facilities to be in full compliance with updated infection prevention regulations which includes a designated infection preventionist on staff and documenting cleaning and disinfection protocols.1

Facility cleanliness can impact reputation and census

- 88% of surveyed Americans agree that they would have a negative view of a skilled nursing facility or longterm care facility if it is not clean.
- Most Americans would switch themselves or a loved one from a long-term care facility if it was consistently dirty (90%) or smelled bad (86%).2

Outbreaks and infections are common and costly

- > 3 out of 4 Norovirus outbreaks in the U.S. can be attributed to long-term care, and each outbreak can cost a facility up to \$48,000.3
- ▶ In one study of 555 residents transitioning from a hospital back to a nursing home, 19% had a healthcare associated infections within 45 days of discharge.4

Pathogens can spread quickly inside and outside of resident rooms

- In one study, up to 49% of surfaces throughout a long-term care facility were contaminated with a viral tracer within 4 hours.5
- One study of 8 long-term care facilities showed that residents and staff come into contact on average 5.8 times an hour in common spaces.6
