
What is COVID-19?

A Guide for Facility Managers





- > Coronaviruses first discovered in 1960s
- **COVID-19** is the respiratory disease caused by the 2019 Novel Coronavirus now known as SARS-CoV-2
- > **Symptoms** of coronavirus infection can range from mild in most cases (fever, cough, shortness of breath) to serious (pneumonia, kidney failure, even death)
- Spreads primarily via droplets produced by coughing or sneezing, people who are asymptomatic and possibly through contact with contaminated surfaces

How to Prevent the Spread of COVID-191



Wash hands

with soap and water, or sanitize hands with alcohol-based hand sanitizer when hand washing is not possible



Cover coughs/sneezes

with a tissue, and then throw the tissue in the trash



Avoid contact

with people showing signs of illness, and stay home if you feel ill



Clean and disinfect surfaces

with products that have an EPA-approved emerging viral pathogen claims for use against SARS-CoV-2



Wear a facemask

to prevent the spread of the disease to others

COVID-19 Prevention Tips for Facility Managers²



Educate your cleaning staff about COVID-19 and encourage them to stay home when sick



Ensure your cleaning staff has access to the right cleaning supplies



Train staff how to properly clean and disinfect high-touch areas to minimize the risk of transmission
