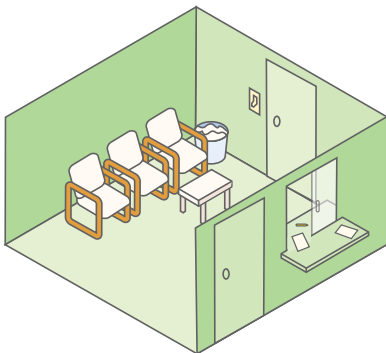

Helpful Reminders

- ▶ Support hand and respiratory hygiene by patients and staff.
- ▶ Be sure to wipe down waiting room areas and other common areas where patients may come in:



Follow These Steps for Effective Disinfecting



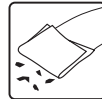
PREPARE

Gather supplies, perform hand hygiene. Put on PPE.



INSPECT

Inspect the surface to see if there is any gross soil or foreign material.



REMOVE

Remove gross visible soil such as blood and saliva before disinfecting.



APPLY

Apply the product to cover the surface.



WAIT

Ensure the surface remains wet for the contact time stated on the product label.



DISCARD

Dispose wipe once you have finished wiping the surfaces.

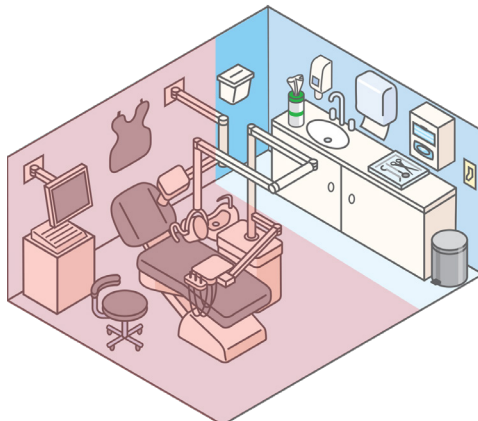
Key Surfaces to Disinfect in Your Dental Operatory

Patient Zone

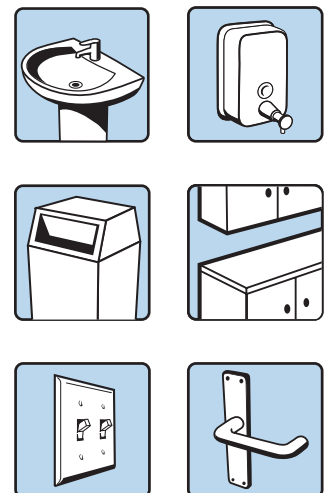


Helpful Tips:

- ▶ Use at least 2 wipes per zone
- ▶ Change wipes when they become soiled or no longer wet surfaces
