Best Practices for Using CloroxPro® Clorox® Germicidal Bleach

Key tips:

- Wear protective eyewear and rubber gloves when using this product.
- To prevent residue build-up, periodically wipe surfaces with a clean damp cloth.
- Clean surface first to remove gross or visible soil.
- Make sure to apply enough diluted bleach solution to keep the surface wet for 5 minutes.
- If necessary, reapply diluted bleach solution to keep the surface wet for 5 minutes.
- Do not reuse soiled wipes.

4. WRING out excess liquid.

What type of cloth can be used?

Common bleach-compatible wipes/cloths include:

- Synthetic dry wipes, best if 100% polyester.
- Microfiber cloths, best if 100% polyester.
- Cotton cloths.
- DO NOT use paper towels to apply bleach, as paper towels will rip and tear.
